Practice Note No. 5 of 1987

Oral examinations before the Court

The Chief Justice has authorized the issue of the following Practice Note:

In any case where an applicant obtains an order for the oral examination of any person, whether the examination is to take place before a Judge or before a Master or before an officer of the Court, the applicant will be required to arrange for a transcript to be taken of the proceedings at the applicant's expense.

Arrangements for the provision of transcripts can be made with authorized private contractors through the Victorian Government Reporting Service.
